Scholastic activities and achievements

"Success has been defined as the dream of yesterday, victory of today and Cherished memory of tomorrow." Yet another academic year of success and achievement unfolded with an honour conferred on AISSE and AISSCE students in the CBSE Board examination.

The result of the CBSE Examinations was quite gratifying with 100% pass both X and XII. In XII all students secured distinction except two. The least total score is 60.2%. Kum. Benedicta Benny is the school topper in Science Stream with 92.6% and Master. Dan Thomas Varghese is the topper in Commerce Stream. All students passed with distinction in English, Business Studies and Accountancy. All scored 70% and above in Economics.

Out of the 27 students in X, there are 21 distinctions, 5 first classes and one second class. School topper Ashley Robby achieved 4 A1 and 1 A2 with 96.4%. Adithyan Anilkumar also scored 4 A1 and 1A2 with 96%. The most remarkable fact is that Adithyan got 100% in Science and Social Science.
